On behalf of the membership and the residents of Qikiqtarjuaq, the Nattivak HTO is submitting it's statement that the Nattivak HTO supports it's harvesters to be allowed limited harvest as the meat is usually shared with the community, and the caribou hunting ground is two to three days away from the community, which one trip with snowmobile cost well over \$1,000 for 1 week of caribou hunt and according to our knowledge harvesters had been harvesting on how much they can bring back.

During the hearings Nattivak will present Community concerns based on the feed back from it's membership and in accordance with 3 options.
