

the fishery data deemed necessary by DFO, including turbot lengths, catch-per-unit effort (CPUE), dates, fishing locations, gear descriptions, and bycatch of all other fish (including sharks and rays), invertebrates (e.g. coral and snails) and marine mammals (including those caught on hooks or entangled in lines) (as outlined in CSAS Science Response 2008/01);

- b) The fishing vessel that conducts the fishery should carry a DFO-approved fisheries observer; and
- c) Iviq HTO should provide a report on the results of the 2013 exploratory fishery to NWMB, DFO and other co-management partners.
