Re: Fisheries and Oceans Canada's Proposal for Decision seeking approval of the 2017 Integrated Fisheries Management Plan for Northern (*Pandalus borealis*) and Striped Shrimp (*P. montagui*)

1. NWMB DECISION

At the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB or Board) March 8th, 2018, in-camera decision-making meeting (IC001-2018), the Board considered the Fisheries and Oceans Canada's *Proposal for Decision* (Proposal) for the approval of the "2017 Integrated Fisheries Management Plan for Northern (*Pandalus borealis*) and Striped Shrimp (*P. montagui*)" and made the following decision:

RESOLVED that, pursuant to Section 5.2.26 and 5.2.34 (d)(i) of the Nunavut Agreement, the NWMB approve the 2017 Integrated Fisheries Management Plan for Northern (Pandalus borealis) and Striped Shrimp (P. montagui).

2. RATIONALE FOR THE NWMB DECISION

On December 22nd, 2017, the NWMB provided public notice that the Board would be conducting a written public hearing to consider Fisheries and Oceans Canada's Proposal on the approval of the 2017 Integrated Fisheries Management Plan for Northern (*Pandalus borealis*) and Striped Shrimp (*P. montagui*). No submissions were received by the February 2nd, 2018, deadline. However, the Torngat Joint Fisheries Board copied the NWMB in their letter to the Minister indicating their support for the approval of the Integrated Fisheries Management Plan (IFMP or Plan).

In addition, during the December 2017 meeting (RM004-2017), two editorial issues with the Plan were identified and brought to the attention of your officials. Fisheries and Oceans Canada addressed both issues and sent NWMB the edited text.

Finally, a representative from the Eastern Arctic Working Group indicated at the December 2017 meeting that they supported the Plan.

In summary:

- No submissions to the written hearing were received;
- The Torngat Joint Fisheries Board shared their letter of support for the Plan;
- The Eastern Arctic Working Group expressed support for the Plan; and
- The edits suggested by the Board were addressed.

3. CONCLUSION

Mister Minister, as per Section 5.3.17 of the *Nunavut Agreement*, the Board hereby forwards its decision to approve the revised 2017 Integrated Fisheries Management Plan for Northern and Striped Shrimp. Please be assured that the NWMB will continue to work collaboratively with Fisheries and Oceans Canada and other co-management partners and stakeholders in ensuring that the management of shrimp aligns with the terms of the *Nunavut Agreement*.
