

# Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit Coordinator Iqaluit, Nunavut

The Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB or Board) is an institution of public government established under the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement*, and situated in Iqaluit, Nunavut. The Board is currently seeking a dynamic individual to fill the new position of Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit Coordinator. The successful applicant will become a key member of a cross-cultural team dedicated to the maintenance of vital, healthy wildlife populations and habitats in Canada's Eastern Arctic.

The IQ Coordinator - reporting to the Board's Executive Director and working closely with the Director of Wildlife Management - will carry out a variety of NWMB IQ/TEK-related programs and activities. In particular, he or she will lead and implement the NWMB's *Inuit Qaujimajatuqangit Program*, as well as consult and collaborate with various co-management partners.

**Qualifications:** Knowledge of wildlife-related IQ principles, beliefs, values, concepts and knowledge, and of Inuit systems of wildlife management is required. Experience working in Nunavut communities and communicating with a broad range of audiences concerning IQ and related wildlife management issues, in a clear and transparent manner would be a definite asset. An understanding of ecological principles and effective research methodologies pertaining to the collection of IQ, the ability to analyze and prepare reports and other documents related to IQ and wildlife management, and experience in developing policies and procedures are desirable assets. Excellent language skills in both written and spoken Inuktitut and a working knowledge of written and spoken English are essential.

**Salary and Benefits:** The NWMB is committed to providing competitive salary levels to its employees. The pay level for this position is negotiable, to be commensurate with qualifications and experience. The Board offers a full package of benefits (housing not provided), including allowances for accommodation, settlement and holiday travel.
