## Out of Kugaaruk:

In May, five Kugaaruk harvesters uploaded data from 25 trips. These trips included over 137,000 waypoints, representing more than 1,400 km of travel route data. Eight harvest records included data on two muskoxen, two caribou, and one polar bear and many char.



## Out of Clyde River:

In Clyde River, eight harvesters collected data on 21 trips. Harvest data were collected on two ringed seals, two ptarmigans, and 79 arctic char.

Data collection for the Community-based Monitoring Network will continue in Clyde River until September.



## Out of Baker Lake

The first travel route and harvest data were recorded in Baker Lake last month. Data was collected from three trips totalling 55 km, and three caribou harvest records were uploaded to the database. Each of the harvest records included a detailed audio file, and a clear image. Great job Baker Lake.

We're looking forward to seeing more data coming in as more harvesters join the program.
