## RE: Species at Risk Act Consultation on Proposed Listing of the Horned Grebe

The Committee on the Status of Endangered Wildlife in Canada (COSEWIC) reviewed the status of the Horned Grebe (Western Population) in April 2009. COSEWIC recommended that the Federal Minister of Environment list the Horned Grebe as a species of <u>Special Concern</u> in Canada under the *Species at Risk Act* (SARA).

Before the Federal Government decides whether to add the Horned Grebe to the SARA list, we need to consult with you. The «Organization» HTO is being consulted because the breeding range of the Horned Grebe includes the very southern part of Nunavut. Your observations and comments on the potential impacts of the listing of the Horned Grebe are important to us. All responses will be reviewed, assessed and weighed for the recommendation as to whether or not the Horned Grebe should be added to the SARA list.

If the Horned Grebe is listed as Special Concern, there would not be any prohibitions or designation of critical habitat, but a national management plan would be prepared for the species. Communities would be consulted on the management plan.

### Purpose of this package is to:

- > Provide the HTO with general information about the *Species at Risk Act* in Nunavut
- Provide the HTO with general information on the Horned Grebe and on the reasons that COSEWIC recommended it to be listed as <u>Special Concern</u>
- Ask the HTO for their position (support, do not support or indifferent) on the proposed listing of Horned Grebe as <u>Special Concern</u>
- Ask the HTO for any other comments, concerns, or information about the proposed listing or about the species that should be considered by the NWMB or the Minister of Environment when deciding whether to list the Horned Grebe under the Species at Risk Act

In your letter or on the response form, please tell us your formal position on the proposed listing of Horned Grebe as Special Concern (i.e. oppose, support or are indifferent) and any other comments, concerns or information that you feel should be considered by the NWMB or the Minister of Environment. It would be appreciated if you would also tell us whether you have seen Horned Grebe around «Community» and whether there is an Inuktitut name for this species.

We request your response by **November 27, 2009** so that we can report your feedback to the NWMB and to the Minister of Environment.


