Written public hearing of the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board to Re: consider the proposed listing of Red-necked Phalarope as Special Concern under the federal Species at Risk Act

The Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB or Board) has scheduled a written public hearing to consider the proposed listing of Red-necked Phalarope as Special Concern under the federal Species at Risk Act.

A written public hearing is one in which all submissions and supporting documentation are filed in writing, and the hearing does not have an oral component. Attached to this letter is a copy of Environment and Climate Change Canada - Canadian Wildlife Service's Proposal for NWMB Decision (Proposal) on the proposed listing of Rednecked Phalarope as Special Concern under the federal Species at Risk Act and the Rules for the NWMB's Written Hearing. Through this letter, the NWMB is extending an invitation to your department or organization to provide written submissions and supporting documentation in response to Environment and Climate Change Canada – Canadian Wildlife Service's Proposal, or otherwise regarding the proposed listing of Red-necked Phalarope as Special Concern under the federal Species at Risk Act. All written materials must be filed with the NWMB – in Inuktitut and English – by no later than 5:00 p.m. (Iqaluit Time) on June 1st 2016. The requirement for translation at the time of filing is mandatory.

Subject to relevant confidentiality or privacy concerns, all submissions and supporting documentation will be placed on the NWMB's website, and will be available for download.

Please take careful note that, unless persuasive written and translated reasons are provided to the Board for late filing, the NWMB will not consider materials for this hearing that are not filed on time.

Submissions and their supporting documentation may be filed with the Board in person, by courier or by mail. They should be clearly marked as pertaining to the *NWMB Written Public Hearing to consider the proposed listing of Red-necked Phalarope as Special Concern.* Delivery of materials may also be made through fax or electronic transmission, but only if your department or organization confirms with the NWMB – prior to the filing deadline – that a complete and legible copy of the transmission has been received by the Board. Materials are deemed to have been filed on the actual day of receipt by the NWMB.

Please keep in mind that the more thorough, reliable and persuasive submissions and supporting documentation are, the more weight they will be given by the NWMB in the *Nunavut Land Claims Agreement* decision-making process. After the deadline for delivery of written submissions, the NWMB will consider all of the relevant evidence and arguments filed, and will make a decision concerning the proposed listing of Rednecked Phalarope as Special Concern under the federal *Species at Risk Act*, which will be forwarded to the Government of Canada Minister of Environment and Climate Change.
