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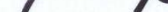

Dear Minister Mike,

Re: Aiviq Hunters and Trappers Organization's (Cape Dorset) request to obtain 5 male polar bear credits from the Foxe Basin subpopulation for use during the 2015-2016 harvest season

On February 16th 2016, the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB or Board) received a letter from the Qikiqtaaluk Wildlife Board regarding a request from the Aiviq Hunters and Trappers Organization (Cape Dorset) to obtain 5 male polar bear credits from the Foxe Basin polar bear subpopulation, for use during the 2015-2016 harvest season (Appendix 1 and 2). The letter indicated that the Qikiqtaaluk Wildlife Board supports the polar bear credit request. This request was presented to the Board during its In-camera meeting (IC 003-2016) on March 16th 2016, where the Board passed the following resolution:

RESOLVED that the NWMB grant the Aiviq Hunters and Trappers Organization five (5) male polar bear credits from the Foxe Basin polar bear subpopulation for use during the 2015-2016 harvest season, which is compliant with the 'Polar Bear Management Memorandum of Understanding for the Management of the Foxe Basin Polar Bear Population' and its associated flexible quota system.

In making this decision, the NWMB considered the credit record for the Cape Dorset Hunters and Trappers Organization from the Foxe Basin subpopulation; the Government of Nunavut – Department of Environment has confirmed that there are 5 male polar bear credits available (Appendix 3). By granting the use of 5 additional polar bear credits, the community quota will increase from 5 (3 male: 2 female) to a total of 10 (8 male, 2 female) for the 2015-2016 harvest season.
