Subject: Resolute Bay and Kimmirut Hunters HTO requests to use polar bear credits for the 2011-2012 harvest season

Dear Mr. Akavak;

Thank you for your letter of December 15, 2011 regarding Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB) decisions related to the use of polar bear credits by the Hunters and Trappers Organizations (HTO) in Resolute Bay and Kimmirut.

I, hereby accept the NWMB decision to approve the credit request of 10 polar bear credits for Resolute Bay for the Lancaster Sound Sub-population. I will instruct the staff to implement the change and distribute additional tags to the Resolute Bay HTO immediately.

With respect to the request from Kimmirut to use 6 polar bear credits from the Davis Strait sub-population, I understand that the NWMB deferred making a decision on this request in consideration of the fact that the NLCA decision making process on changes to the Davis Strait Total Allowable Harvest is ongoing. As I have recently received your final decision on this matter I hope to see a final resolution as soon as possible.
