

**Decision: X**

<sup>1</sup> Stuck and loss can be defined as the following: An animal is said to be “struck” when it is hit by a weapon (e.g. harpoon) or by a projectile (e.g. bullet). An animal is said to be “lost” when it either (a) is injured and escapes the hunter or (b) is killed but not landed or lost during the landing process.

- a. The formation of a working group with NTI and DFO to prepare a draft agenda and discuss workshop participants;
- b. The provision of a report to the NWMB following the workshop that identifies issues and recommendations on how to move forward with addressing marine mammal struck and loss management issue.
