This is definitely a good thing for the HTO. Under the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement the NWMB needs to set Total Allowable Harvest (TAH) and Basic Needs Levels (BNL) for species in Nunavut. For Peary Caribou the meeting to set these numbers will take place next week. The more accurate the number we can have for harvested peary caribou the more accurate the basic needs level number we can provide for peary caribou. Would you agree that the numbers that I have indicated below for harvested peary caribou in Grise over the past 5 years is accurate?
