1. We all know that there is perceived to be few caribou left on Baffin Island. We also know that there are still some left on the island. We feel that the Inuit on Baffin Island should not be completely cut off from harvesting caribou because it is their food. We think two or three caribou should be allowed per household for a year.
2. Awhile number of caribou on the Baffin Island are below basic needs level, other harvesters such as people purchase permits from DOE and government funded institutions such as: Baffin Correctional Center, Schools and etc. should be banned from harvesting.
3. Females and calves should be harvested until further study done.
4. Implement bounty for kill a wolf.
5. There should be another caribou survey after two years.
6. If there is going to be total ban or limited harvest for caribou, DOE law enforcement will have to be fully staffed and have proper training. They will have to improve their presence to the hunters at their hunting grounds.
