There are lots of arctic char being caught in the waterways near Kugaaruk during this cold winter.

March will be the last full month of data collection for Kugaarumiut harvesters.

Project wrap-up meetings, are scheduled for April 27 and 28. We will look over the data collected, and talk about your experience with the project.

Did you collect harvest data for the Monitoring Network between December 2018 and March 31, 2019?

Baker Lake:

The Project Team will be coming to Baker Lake on March 27 and 28 to hold a workshop with harvesters interested in collecting data for the Community-based Monitoring Network. Using open discussion, we will provide background about how the project came to be, and a history of the project in other communities. This will be followed by hands-on training, including an opportunity to take the devices on the land and try them out in real conditions. We will identify local wildlife concerns and sort out how to use this approach to best benefit Baker Lake.
