WILDLIFE ACT

**GAME HARVESTING AND POSSESSION LIMITS ORDER**

1. No resident, non-resident or non-resident foreigner shall, during the period from July 1 in one year to June 30 in the next year, harvest a species listed in Schedule A in a quantity that exceeds the limit specified in that Schedule for the species and the status of the person.
2. No resident, non-resident or non-resident foreigner shall, in a day, harvest a species listed in Schedule B in a quantity that exceeds the limit specified in that Schedule for the species and the status of the person.
3. No resident, non-resident or non-resident foreigner shall at any time possess a species listed in Schedule C in a quantity that exceeds the limit specified in that Schedule for the species and the status of the person.
4. This Order does not apply in respect of any species for which a total allowable harvest is established.
