



NOTICE OF ADJOURNMENT OF NUNAVUT WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT BOARD PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is provided on April 10th 2015 that the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB) has decided to adjourn its in-person public hearing to consider the establishment of a management unit and total allowable harvest for Foxe Basin walrus for an indefinite period of time. The public hearing was previously scheduled for April 15th and 16th 2015 at the community hall in Igloodik, Nunavut.

On April 1st 2015, the NWMB received a written request from Fisheries and Oceans Canada for a postponement of the hearing to allow an opportunity to review newly identified scientific information. This request and all other relevant documents pertaining to the hearing are available for download from the NWMB's website (www.nwmb.com), or by directly contacting the NWMB at the coordinates set out at the end of this notice.

The NWMB is committed to making its decisions based on careful consideration of the best available information and has therefore decided to adjourn its in-person public hearing until the new Fisheries and Oceans Canada information becomes publicly available and relevant communities have been consulted. Please be advised that the NWMB will, in due course, issue another notice announcing new dates for the hearing and filing of submissions.
