Dear NWMB,

Please accept this letter as a request to provide the NWMB with updates regarding the Nunavut General Monitoring Plan (NGMP) at its upcoming board meeting on June 10-16, 2011.

Article 12.7.6 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement requires that government and the Nunavut Planning Commission cooperate to develop and implement a plan for monitoring the current and cumulative long-term environmental impacts of development in Nunavut. This plan is referred to as the NGMP, and is governed by Nunavut Tunngavik Incorporated (NTI), the Government of Nunavut (GN), the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) and Indian and Northern Affairs Canada/Government of Canada (INAC/GoC).

As per the NGMP Business Case (December 2008), the NWMB is considered an IPG constituent to NGMP. This relationship provides the NWMB with an opportunity to help identify wildlife monitoring information gaps, issues, networks for sharing information, and wildlife and resource monitoring opportunities that would enhance decision-making within Nunavut.

As NGMP continues to develop, we look forward to working closely with our partners. To this end, we cordially request the opportunity to share more information with the NWMB regarding NGMP and to address any questions you may have.
