

NOTICE OF NUNAVUT WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT BOARD AND NUNAVIK MARINE REGION WILDLIFE BOARD JOINT WRITTEN HEARING

Notice is provided on April 2, 2021, that the Nunavut Wildlife Management Board (NWMB) and the Nunavik Marine Region Wildlife Board (NMRWB) will be conducting a joint written public hearing to consider Fisheries and Oceans Canada's *Proposal for Decision* to the Boards (Proposal) seeking recommendations and decisions on the total allowable catch levels for Northern and Striped shrimp in the Eastern and Western Assessment Zones for the 2021/2022 fishing season. The Proposal also requests decisions from the Boards on the continuation of the practice whereby both northern and striped shrimp allocations in Nunavut-West and Nunavik-West, and the Nunavut-East and Nunavik-East, may be harvested in either management unit, regardless of land claim boundaries. The filing of submissions:

The Boards are inviting interested organizations or persons, including any member of the public, to file written response submissions and supporting documentation concerning the Proposal by no later than **5:00 p.m. Iqaluit/Inukjuak time on April 30, 2021.** Unless persuasive written reasons are provided for late filing, the Boards will not consider materials for this hearing that are not filed on time. The Boards will make publicly available all written materials filed with them, subject to relevant confidentiality or privacy concerns.
